Thank you to those who attended the Parent Meeting last Tuesday! Since marching season is over, it doesn't seem like we get to see each other as much....

We talked about the calendar of events for the remainder of the school year. Please note that band students are required to play at the CHS graduation (on 5/22), but that ceremony is AFTER the last day of school (on 5/20). There are a number of students who have not returned their marching uniforms.

Last Tuesday, our uniform volunteers were in the Band room to accept all returns. There are still many, many uniforms checked out to students.

Students must return the following items: Garment bag, shako (hat), shako box, bibbers and jacket. No exceptions can be made. Each uniform is valued at

about \$400 and we really DON'T want to charge any family for them. You do NOT need to have them cleaned before you return them. We will take care of that with the \$10 uniform maintenance fee you paid, at the beginning of the year.

Now, students can bring their items to the band room any school day. The uniforms should be given to one of the Directors. Unfortu-
