During the Board meeting and the Parent meeting, we talked about fundraising ideas, given the current health/social climate. Ideas include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Poster project with parents purchasing personal ads for their students and/or attempting to sell ads to local businesses. We do not expect local businesses to be able to do this under current circumstances.
2. Goat Milk Soap Sale with delivery direct to customers and/or a drive through pick-up once all orders are delivered. This is a successful sale for us in the past and people are in need of soap now more than ever.
3. Snapshare fundraiser, similar to that of the CHS Football program recently.
4. We'd love to continue our Golf Tournament, but there are some new logistics to this now and we need someone willing to guide this effort. PLEASE, please consider helping with this.
5. Finally, we cannot afford to lose momentum with our Craft Faire. This usually takes place in November and we are looking for help/guidance with moving this to an online event. Last year, we earned about \$12,000; but we need some expertise with this new modality. Can you or someone you know at least answer some questions for us? Please let Jeni know.

Band Fee Structure Changes—Again

So, we will continue to be grateful for your patience and flexibility—even though we know how hard it is for things to keep changing.

Here's the latest about band fees.

We will NOT be charging a class fee while we are still on remote learning. Once, we move into a hybrid (yellow) or normal (green) schedule, then the class fee will be reinstated. This fee, which totals \$100 is usually charged at \$50 per semester. However, this year we will charge it by the 9-weeks. So, the LCPS Superintendent has determined that we will be in Red (all remote) for the entire first 9 weeks. Therefore, no class fee will be charged for that same time period. If we come back for the 2nd 9 weeks, then we will charge the remaining quarters at \$25/each.

The bottom line is that, for now, the class fee has been reduced by \$25 for the current school year. The fee will be reinstated when we return and the total amount due adjusted accordingly. So, please don't worry about paying and fees until the students return to campus is some way.

Clearly, this will also have an impact on our budget and the Board will work with the Directors to make further cuts. Have you thought about how you can help with fundraising?
