# Fundraising Updates

We have a few fundraisers going on right now and we want to share the progress with you.

1. SNAP raise has been truly unbelievable. As of 1:50 pm Sunday morning, we have raised \$22,620! This has easily become our easiest and most successful fundraiser ever. Thank you to those who have participated, to every single donor and to our Coordinator Julie Gustafson! We have about 9 days left, so keep sharing those links on social media.
2. Julie is also heading up efforts for our First Annual 5K (Rock the Hawks), which will take place on September 18. Their next meeting is tomorrow night at 6:00 pm in the Band Room.
3. Amazon Smile is ongoing and we've been receiving quarterly checks of about \$50 each. It's not much, but maybe it will pick up as Holiday shopping looms.
4. Concessions has begun! Typically, we can expect to earn about \$12,000 per football season. We need about 20 volunteers per game.
